DRESS CODE REMINDER

Please be sure to review our uniform and dress code policy on pages 40-42 of our Archway Family Handbook. Our faculty and staff are doing their best to log any dress code infractions which you should be receiving.

With cooler weather approaching, please review the outerwear dress code:

Sweaters:

- Color: Navy blue with the MVA Crest
- Style: Cardigan or pullover with a ¼ zipper
- Available from Dennis Uniforms and Anton Uniforms

Outerwear/Jackets:

- Jackets may be worn to school for warmth but must be free of logos and messages
- Definition: Waterproof fabric or wool, with zipper or buttons, and a single color scheme no words or images allowed
- Jackets may only be worn before school, after school, and during recess Other items:
 - Beanies and gloves are allowed when it's cold but must be single-color and free of logos or messages
 - Cardigans with the MVA Crest may be worn inside and outside the classroom
- Long sleeve undershirts are not permitted

GALILEO TESTING

Galileo testing is quickly approaching! The Galileo assessment is a valuable tool that helps us understand your scholars' progress and make informed decisions to support their academic growth.

Here are some essential details and tips to help your child prepare for the upcoming Galileo Testing:

Testing Dates:

·Galileo Testing will take place on Wednesday, October 29.

Test Preparation:

- ·Encourage your scholar to review class notes and materials to reinforce their learning.
- ·Ensure they have a quiet and well-lit space for studying and homework.
- $\cdot \text{Be supportive and provide a positive environment for their preparation.} \\$

Test-Day Essentials:

- ·On test days, please ensure that your scholar arrives at school on time.
- ·Make sure they get a good night's sleep and have a nutritious breakfast.

PSAT

The PSAT for 10th and 11th-grade students will take place on **Tuesday, October 21, at 8:00 a.m.** Students should arrive by **7:45 a.m.** and expect testing to last about three hours.

Why the PSAT Matters:

The PSAT helps students prepare for the SAT and provides valuable feedback on their academic strengths and areas for growth. It also serves as the National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test, which can open doors to college scholarships and recognition.

What to Bring:

A water bottle and a snack for the break

How to Prepare:

- Review the PSAT format and content, focusing on math and evidence-based reading and writing
- Practice with official PSAT materials provided by HL and math teachers

Tips for Success:

- Encourage your scholar to get a good night's sleep and eat a healthy breakfast
- Offer support and reassurance to help ease any test-day nerves
