A MESSAGE FROM ARCHWAY HEADMASTER DR. CRUZ

Dear Maryvale Prep Families,

We hope that you have seen by now our note about us attaining an "A" letter grade from the Arizona Department of

Education. This has been years in the making and with just as much work as it required to attain an "A", it will take just as much to maintain it. Here are some things that you already are or can continue doing to partner to keep us on an upward trajectory.

- Send your child to Academic Morning Clubs
 - We review progress monitoring and test data to determine exactly which students and which skills to target during these morning blocks. Their attendance solidifies their understanding and historically data has shown us that those who attend consistently score better from one test to another.
- Encourage reading at home daily and ask comprehension questions or ask your child to tell you what they read about. Success on standardized assessments that begin in 2nd and 3rd grades are often measure by early literacy scores. Students who leave Kindergarten reading on grade level are more likely to maintain proficiency on standardized tests.
- Attend parent teacher conferences, Family Partnership Night and any school events that are geared towards providing you with resources to help your child.
- Shift screen time so that more time is spent on IXL review versus video games and non-essential screen time.
- Ensure punctuality and consistent attendance. Not only does being here ensure your child is learning, our funding and scores are tied to
 attendance and punctuality. Furthermore, consistency now, sets your child up to be consistent and punctual in their future.

Thank you for all that you do to partner with us. Again, this recognition belongs to parents as well!



UPCOMING FIELD DAYS

On Wednesday, November 19th, our Kindergarten students will have their Athletic Field Day. Parents are welcome to come as spectators but must drop their child off as normal and then return to park and enter through the main office no earlier than 8:15 am. Parents must sign in and will be escorted to the lawn. Game rounds begin at 8:30 am. Parents must leave campus at 10:35 am at the end of Round 4. Sweaters: Color: Navy blue with the MVA Crest Style: Cardigan or pullover with a 1/4

zipper
Available from Lands'End
Outerwear/Jackets:
Jackets may be worn to school for warmth but must be free of logos and

messages
Definition: Waterproof fabric or wool, with zipper or buttons, and a single color scheme — no words or images allowed

Jackets may only be worn before school, after school, and during recess

Other items:

Beanies and gloves are allowed when it's cold but must be single-color and free of logos or messages
Cardigans with the MVA Crest may be worn inside and outside the classroom

Long sleeve undershirts are not permitted

OUTERWEAR POLICY

As the weather begins to cool, we'd like to remind families of our outerwear policy to ensure all students remain in compliance with the school dress code:


Approved Campus Outerwear:

 Students may wear a school pullover or athletic jacket with the official school crest or approved emblem at all times during the school day.

Non-Academy Outerwear:

- Jackets or coats without the school crest may be worn before and after school, <u>outdoors</u> <u>only</u>. These must be free of pop culture references, political messages, or any inappropriate language or images.
