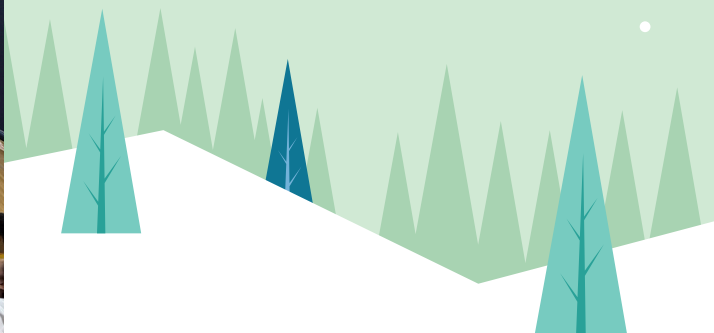

## HOMEWORK DEFICIENCY NOTICE

Beginning in January, Homework Deficiency notices will no longer be sent home weekly. All Prep students and families can view current grades through the Parent Portal, which is accessible on both phones and computers. Teachers will be communicating directly with parents for significant academic and behavior concerns.

Please make sure you and your student are checking the Parent Portal regularly and contacting your student's teachers with any questions. The portal shows all missing assignments, homework, participation, quiz and test grades, as well as any comments from teachers. Gradebooks are updated each Monday by 8:00 a.m.

Mid-quarter reports, quarter and semester student evaluations will still be sent out as usual. If you need assistance accessing your Parent Portal account, please contact the front office.

## SEMESTER FINALS

### Semester Finals – December 17-19

Students wrap up each semester by taking Semester Exams. Semester Exams are an important part of the educational processes. These are comprehensive assessments, spanning the curriculum taught across the full semester and account for 10% of the semester grade. Students take two exams per day on the final three days of the semester, **December 17-19. All three days are Early Release Schedule.**

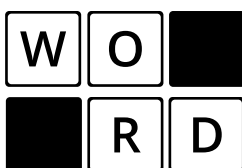
It is important that students are present, on-time, and prepared for their exams. Do not plan for winter break travel to begin until after Finals are completed. **Students will not be exempted from taking the exams for travel or other unexcused absences and will receive a zero on any missed exams.** Exams are not given early, so families should make every effort to have their students present for those dates. Students can make up missed finals on Monday, January 5<sup>th</sup>.

**Study Guides will be distributed by teachers no later than December 12th.** Please support your student's preparation by reviewing their study guide instructions with them and allow them appropriate time and place to study. If you have any questions on a particular final exam, please reach out to that teacher.
